

# TRAFFIC AMNESTY

## Public Amnesty Program: State to Discount Old Unpaid Traffic Tickets!!

California Superior Courts in all 58 counties are offering a 50% off discount on some old unpaid traffic tickets. It's a limited-time "Amnesty Program" for certain outstanding court debts. More than 6 million cases statewide could qualify.

- ❖ The program begins January 1, 2012, and ends June 30, 2012.
- ❖ Only traffic tickets that were due to be paid before January 1, 2009, are eligible.
- ❖ Parking tickets, driving under the influence (DUI), and reckless driving cases are **NOT** eligible.

To qualify for the 50% discount, all of the following conditions must be met:

- ✓ You have an outstanding traffic case that was due to be paid in full before January 1, 2009
- ✓ You either failed to appear in court or failed to pay in full
- ✓ The last date a payment was made was on or before January 1, 2009
- ✓ You don't owe restitution to a victim on any case within the county where the traffic case was filed
- ✓ You have no outstanding misdemeanor or felony warrants within the county where the traffic case was filed
- ✓ Other eligibility requirements may vary from county to county.
